



If you are a resident of a Pettis County school district (or the school districts of Cole Camp, Windsor, Lincoln, Otterville, Warsaw, Knob Knoster, Sweet Springs, Tipton, or Versailles), a graduating high school senior and plan on pursuing a four-year degree in an agriculture related field of study, you are eligible for the Central Missouri Agriculture Club Agriculture Future of America (AFA) scholarship.

This scholarship supports college tuition and fees in the amount of \$3,200 and includes sponsorship to the AFA Leaders Conference (a \$1,000 value) during the fall of your freshman year of college. The AFA Leaders Conference focuses on personal and professional development and is held annually in Kansas City, Missouri.

AFA is helping today's youth become tomorrow's leaders in agriculture by offering scholarship, internship and leadership development for agriculture collegians.
