Aaron Diggs moved to approve the agenda, seconded by Patsy Reed. 6-0, motion carried.

Bo Helms moved to approve the consent agenda, seconded by Kent Fischer. 6-0, motion carried with Clint abstained from all invoices. The consent agenda contained the following items:

Under the superintendent report, Dr. Terry Robinson briefly mentioned the bond issue reduction in the dollar amount. Dr. Robinson also talked about the built in snow days. Dr. Robinson discussed the covid money from Moniteau county, ESSER II money. He will have recommendations for spending the ESSER money at a future date. Insurance quotes will discuss more in new business.

Under administrator reports Mrs. Leeanna Meador, Mr. Jason Culpepper, Mr. Kelly Kohler and Ms. Nancy Thomas (virtual) were available to answer questions regarding their reports.

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Under old business, Dr. Robinson talked about repurposing the old central office. The old central office could be used for storage which then could eliminate the multiple storage sheds behind the maintenance building. No vote taken but consensus was to go ahead and do what needs to be done.

Under new business, Craig Wolf moved to approve the tuition rate to remain the same for the 2021-2022 school year at \$7500, seconded by Aaron Diggs, 7-0 motion carried

Bo Helms moved to approve the OSBA 2021-2022 agreement, seconded by Kent Fischer. 7-0, motion carried.

Bo Helms moved to approve the to raise the board paid insurance to \$518, seconded by Craig Wolf. 7-0, motion carried.
