Course Overview

The 8th Grade Music Appreciation is a continuation of the sequential time periods and genres started in 7th Grade Music Appreciation. Here, in 8th Grade we start with American Folk Music in Unit 1 and how it was shaped through the 20th century.

In Unit 2 students will discover, identify, and analyze influential Rock musicians in the 20th century.

In Unit 3 students will continue that sequence through the Pop music genre and into the 21st century.

Students will be able to identify songs from historical time periods. Students will be able to identify facts related to the world around them how music influenced culture. Students will have an awareness of influential figures in music history.
